City of Kenai Expands Land Development and Leasing Incentives City-Wide

KENAI, AK-- The City of Kenai has expanded its development and leasing incentives from properties at the Kenai Municipal Airport to the entire City-owned land inventory.

Notable incentives include no lease payments for up to five years and opportunities for lease or lease with the option to purchase.

Over 300 available properties are included in the new lease incentives, many of which are suitable for businesses catering to transportation, tourism, outdoor recreation, and service industries.

Leases also include business friendly policies and practices, making it an optimal situation for entrepreneurs and business-owners alike.

“One of the City’s greatest assets is its land inventory, and we are committed to utilizing City lands to spur responsible economic growth and improve the quality of life for Kenai residents through these incentives, as well as creating an environment that makes Kenai the best place to do business,” says Kenai Mayor Brian Gabriel.

The City offers development incentives to encourage investment in the form of a credit applied toward rent for a maximum of five years.
